Associate Responsibilities:

- Collaborate with the Shift Manager, Project Manager and other Associates, as well as work independently to sort belongings into keep, sell, donate, or discard categories
- Safely and systematically pack belongings for moving or shipping
- Document the location and arrangement of favored items using photographs to facilitate their setup in the new home
- Relocate items from one location to another efficiently and effectively
- Set up items in the new location based on photographic records of the previous residence, creating familiarity and continuity
- Respond to client inquiries or concerns regarding the tasks for the day
- Direct any client questions about the moving process to the Shift Lead or Project Manager, whichever is running the shift, for appropriate guidance
- Ensure that items are unpacked in the new space without any damage, creating a comfortable and organized environment
- Create an organized system that clients can utilize to maintain order and ease
- Tag all drawers and cupboards with short bulleted lists of items to be found within
